

Growing With God

Why do we work hard to cultivate opportunities and environments for everyday people to **encounter Jesus**? Because we believe that meeting Jesus face-to-face results in worship, trust, and rest in Jesus - and an increasing hunger for God. We speak, sing, and rehearse stories of redemption and healing that inspire; we equip, train, and send disciples; we intentionally support one another in a broadening network of spiritual and relational interconnectedness. **We internalize** and externalize Christ 24/7.

Kurt Knochel, a volunteer and elder in our church family, took part in a Disciple-Making training opportunity last year (many people did this!) and, in his own words (right), grew in his life with God and in his spiritual confidence toward the people he encounters every day.

"I am not an outgoing person, and I have never considered myself 'an evangelizer.' However, since participating in disciple-making training course, I have started mentoring others. One of these friendships began as just a professional thing, but now it's become more of a life thing. This person ultimately told me he needed to reestablish his relationship with Jesus and asked if I could help! It kind of fell into my lap, but I was prepared to hear that - and to act on it. I remember thinking, 'I didn't do anything', but I did. That was part of what the training prepared me to do: listening for the Holy Spirit and having my eyes and ears open. And so, when this came up, I jumped on it, whereas in the past, I maybe would have thought about talking to him about it sometime in the next month instead of being ready to respond right away. It was simple; I started with, 'Here are some things in life that I've learned recently.', and just went from there."


2024 Financial Update


