Title: Director of Harbortown Movement

PURPOSE OF THE ROLE

The Director of Harbortown Movement will be responsible for the vision, direction, and coordination of all elements and locations of the Harbortown movement. Providing opportunities and positively enhancing spiritual growth for children, while accomplishing the overall vision in alignment with the Whitewater movement.

ESSENTIAL JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

Cleves Campus (in person)

- Coordinates age appropriate weekend discipleship and worship environments for all Harbortown departments
- Casts clear vision, as well as implementing movement strategies, into a healthy culture of Harbortown
- Disciple, equip, and support the Harbortown staff and other high level leaders, while teaching them to be disciplers
- Works with each Harbortown staff member to design strategies, set ministry goals, and evaluate progress
- Oversees physical environment and resources of the Harbortown movement
- Ensures that Harbortown is fulfilling the mission and vision of Whitewater
- Oversees and manages the Harbortown budget and finances

Online Campus

- Oversees the content to make sure it is relevant and age appropriate
- Developing new strategies to reach children through the online vehicle
- Ensure delivery of the message (content) is accomplished through innovative ways and at acceptable levels of "excellence."
- Planning for opportunities to constantly brainstorm best practices and new ways to complete the vision



In- Person (future development)

- Leads the future development of children's ministry for the Whitewater Movement
- Oversees and leads in the growth and expansion of Harbortown opportunities to accomplish the vision/mission of the movement
- Oversees the creative planning and execution of Harbortown events throughout the year
- Provides leadership to the Harbortown movement for future endeavours
- Leads/participates in Children's Ministry related meetings and staff development meetings, both within and outside of the Movement
- Performs other duties as needed by the Movement and assigned by the Executive Pastor of Ministry
